Prison Club Update

22 men have completed applications to join Toastmasters and have asked the prison to cut checks to Toastmasters International from their inmate trust funds. We are forming our first club at California State Prison, Solano in Vacaville and will have our first official Toastmasters meeting on June 11. Once we get up to 40 + men, we will start a second club. We could still use a few more volunteers to help. The prison was built in 1984 and this will be their first ever Toastmaster club. They have one Gavel Club on the Level 3 side. Kudos to Brian Richards and Eddie Vierra.

We get to count them three times (charter, Oct and Apr renewals) if they are chartered by Aug 31. I will continue working with our incoming Lt Governor Marketing Sondra Nunez to insure that happens. These leads include Esurance in Rocklin, Immigration Services at 650 Capitol Mall, community club in South Lake Tahoe, and Sutter Davis Hospital.


