- We have been providing information to the Audit committee as they finalize the Midyear Audit: Thank you again 2021-2022 District 39 Audit Committee Members for all your valued work: Sondra Nunez DTM-Committee Chair Zackary Souza DTM Christine Gerety VC3
- The Trio: Denise Alder Gurthez PQD, Lance McMahan CGD and I virtually attended Midyear Training January 15, 22 and 29th. We learned valuable information and received additional training. We also had an opportunity to network with Toastmasters International Leaders from International and other Districts and Regions..
- In an opportunity to increase membership the Executive Committee voted to authorize District 39 to spend \$5,850 from our reserve funds to participate in Toastmasters International's worldwide advertising campaign focused on LinkedIn (a few on Facebook)
 2/3 majority of the Executive Committee voted to participate: 33 said yes to one no vote.. See complete Toastmasters International letter on page 5 of my report.

• We currently have 119 clubs in good standing. Congratulations to Club 1528 Speaking Machine as being the first club to have at least eight members paid and are verified complete. Please remind our members to pay their dues early as payments for the next renewal period are now being accepted. If your club is striving for on-time credit in the Distinguished Club Program, please submit all payments on or before April 1, 2022. As an additional reminder, the minimum membership requirement for a club to remain in good standing is eight members—at least three of whom must be renewing from the previous membership period. Club memberships effect the District Structure

Protocol 7.0: District Structure

The best interests of the clubs and District are taken into consideration when assigning clubs to Areas.

- I. Areas consist of four (4) to six (6) clubs; however, an Area may consist of three (3) clubs on July 1 only when an effort to charter a fourth club is in process.
- II. Under no circumstances may an Area have more than six (6) clubs on July 1.
- III. Advanced clubs may not be segregated into Areas.
- IV. Areas may be segregated by language, subject to the approval of the District Council.
- V. Districts assign clubs to Areas based upon:
 - a. Geographic proximity to other clubs
 - b. The ability of an Area Director to effectively provide service, without requiring the clubs to change how meetings are conducted to accommodate an Area Director visit
 - c. Club size and strength (e.g., paid, active, disbanding)
 - d. Prospective clubs and expected growth
 - e. The likelihood of eligibility for Distinguished programs (e.g., club base of the Area or Division)
- B. A Division must have a minimum of three (3) Areas.

We were recently informed 16 clubs listed as suspended will be removed from our roster April 1st if not reinstated. (3 renewing members and at least 8 fully paid members) by April 1, 2022.
