ATTRACTING NEW CLUB VISITORS WITH MEETUPS

This month The PR team wanted to focus on different methods clubs have used to attract visitors to their club meetings. Open house events, social media, and word of mouth are all free methods for attracting new visitors to your Toastmasters club.

But in July, Tracy Toastmasters had three new guests attend their meeting and two of them were the result of *Meetups*. I was so intrigued I asked David Goad if he could do some research and provide information about Meetups that could be shared with District 39.



What are MEETUPS?

Meetups www.Meetup.com is a paid tool that IS helping clubs attract visitors.

Clubs may have available funds to invest or possibly collaborate with a few Area clubs to try it out, but Meetups are proving to be worth the investment in attracting visitors to your club. Sometimes it's not the cost... it's the VALUE of your promotion activity that keeps your club strong!

Check out this article for an excellent basic guide to how it's being used in District 96. If you are already using Meetups successfully, please share your results and tips for other clubs in the District 39 Facebook members group.
