DECM October 10, 2020: District Director's Report

1. The subsequent voting period following the September 2020 District 39 Council Meeting resulted in a quorum. Here are the results of the vote:

The district club and area alignment, division and area director appointments, and the district budget were all approved and/or accepted.

2. Our Membership Renewal Drive ended September 30. Our renewal rate was 59.7%. Even though this number compares favorably within Region 1 (4 of 9), it is well below the expected rate. But membership renewal never ends. It's important to renew so that members are able to continue to utilize Pathways online.
3. There have been several leadership changes. Kimberley Moses (Area 43) and Ann Owens (Area 93) have decided to step down. They are fine leaders and Toastmasters who remain in good standing and will be missed. Excellent Toastmaster Jim Lee will step up to lead A43, while the venerable Joey Waldrop will perform "double duty" and lead Area 93. Thank you all.
4. I recently had discussions with John Pasamonte and George Jarosik. The excellent Toastmasters are involved in membership and club growth, technical issues, Zoom management, Pathways, and always helping others. They don't know how to say "no." Their capabilities and services are coveted by many. Because of their special talents and the demand for them from others in Toastmasters at the Regional and possibly International levels, we agreed that they will step down from their District 39 Webmaster responsibilities.

Immediate Past District Director Wes Johnson, who is very capable (and generous), has agreed to perform as Webmaster for an unspecified period. I am also announcing that I am canvassing the District for anyone who might be interested in performing Webmaster duties and have working knowledge of "WordPress" or other content management systems.
